This position will be expected to take over responsibility from day one and is open to foreign nationals with experience in Iraq (or the MENA region).

#### Your Tasks

Working closely with the BACK TO LIFE project team in Dohuk and the project and communications team in Berlin, Germany, the PROJECT DEVELOPMENT and ADVOCACY position encompasses the following tasks and responsibilities:

- Develop and implement creative and practical ideas for strengthening the impact and quality of current projects (i.e., BACK TO LIFE) by working with the local and Berlin teams to identify new and address current areas of need.



- Define and implement **local and regional political advocacy strategy** in the fields of women's empowerment, protections of minorities, and reconciliation.
- Help identify **future funding sources** for existing and new projects and help construct funding proposals with the team in Berlin.
- Build a **network of relevant civil society, government, and private sector** and in Iraq and the wider MENA region.
- Develop advocacy and project content for **blog posts, social media posts** and a **monthly newsletter** in coordination with the communications team in Berlin.
- Keep up to date on **current events surrounding justice for crimes against humanity, the rights of minorities, and women's empowerment in Iraq in and the MENA region** and identify opportunities for action.
- Support on **reporting to funding partners**, including compiling reports for public funders.

### Your Profile

- At least 3 years of related work-experience in an international NGO, government, foundation or related.
- Experience working in an international development context (preferably in the MENA region).
- Bachelor's degree (Master's preferred) in a related field: international development, women's studies, public policy, management etc.
- Open-minded with an understanding of the political and cultural landscape in Iraq.
- Experience and/or interest in women's empowerment work.
- Flexible and independent working style with the ability to take on multiple tasks at once.
- Fluent in English or German, and good knowledge of either Arabic or Kurdish.
- Strong communications skills, skills in social media are a plus.
